This audit assesses compliance with the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations (PECR).

AI ANALYSIS

The website tinysystems.io was audited on May 20, 2026. Key compliance issues include the absence of a cookie consent banner and non-compliance with GDPR Article 7 and PECR Regulation 6 requirements for obtaining user consent before setting non-essential cookies. The overall risk assessment is critical due to potential legal penalties and reputational damage.

NON-COMPLIANT

The website is currently non-compliant with GDPR and PECR regulations regarding user consent for cookies. Immediate action is required to implement a compliant cookie consent banner.

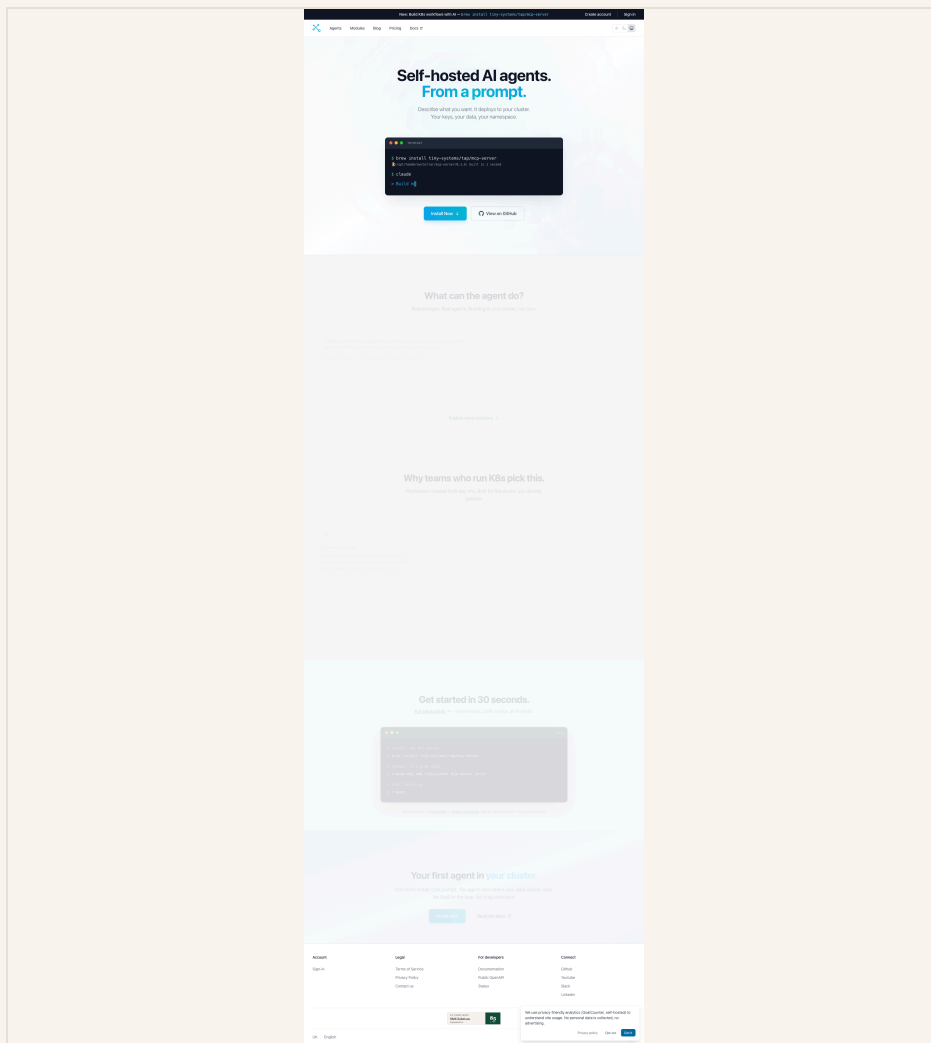
